






EXECUTIVE ORDER N-56-20

- Changes to 2020-2021 LCAP
- Extends the deadline for 20-21 LCAP to Dec. 15, 2020
- New reporting requirement for LEAs to provide an overview of the changes in program in response to COVID-19, by budget adoption July 1, 2020.
- Delays implementation of the three-year LCAP template to 2021 -2024.
